The Great *Gulf News* Trolley Derby Sunday 3 September 2023 @ 10am, Ocean View Road, Oneroa

Thank you for being part of our trolley derby. Before you fill out the declaration and entry form we ask that you carefully read the following terms and conditions.

The mustering area is on Ocean View Road before the first roundabout. Compulsory scrutineering is at Blackpool School Hall Sunday 20 August between 10am to 1pm. Final check at 8.00am on the day in the pits. First race 10am. Rain date 17 September 2023. This is a waste free event. Please return entry forms to Gulf News office, Unit K, 118 Ocean View Road Oneroa, behind Pendragon Mall.

- Each trolley/box cart shall have a driver and a team of supporters.
- There will be a restricted push zone at the top of the race course trolleys and box carts can be pushed only in this zone and must then be let go.
- · All drivers must wear approved safety helmets, closed-toe footwear, gloves long sleeves and pants or elbow and
- Each race will have a maximum number of trolleys/carts, determined by the judges.
- Heats will be held in an endeavour to accommodate all trolleys/box carts and a final will be held to ascertain the overall winner.
- Trolleys and box carts may be entered in more than one class with appropriate driver/pushers.
- Trolleys/carts have one entry per class, per driver.
- The first trolley or box cart past the post is the winner.
- · All entrants enter these races at their own risk. The driver and pusher or guardians of children will need to sign a waiver form before they will be able to race.
- All entrants must be the specified age as at race day Sunday 3 September 2023.
- Race directions are at the discretion of the stewards and instructions are to be followed by entrants at all times.
- All children between the ages of five to 15 are only permitted to race in box carts (wheel size restricted to 300mm).
- All children under 16 years must be under parental supervision.

- · All trolleys and box carts must be available for compulsory scrutineering on Sunday 20 August at Old Blackpool School Hall between 10am to 1pm.
- Trolleys/carts must be home made and in a safe condition.
- Trolleys/carts must have effective brakes and be able to stop unaided.
- All trolleys/carts must have minimum of three wheels but no more than six wheels.
- Maximum trolley and cart length is 2.5 metres no push poles.
- Rope steered trolleys must have a foot brake.
- There shall be no dangerous extensions or protrusions from the trolley or cart.
- All Young Guns Box Carts (children under 16 years old) are to have a maximum wheel diameter of 300 mm.
- Open Class trolleys are to have a maximum wheel diameter of 700 mm.
- The weight of all trolleys and box carts, without the driver, is limited to 70 kgs, no ballast allowed.
- Each new trolley/cart will be allocated a number. Numbers will be confirmed by judges on final safety inspection.
- The scrutineer's decision is final.
